PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Two thousand and twenty-one was a year of continuing challenges, though our fundraising activities adapted well to an on-line environment and our outstanding and energetic Marketing and Fundraising Committee held two major on-line events in 2021. While these were primarily fundraising events, the OKI Vibrational Healing event and the Speaker Summit – 4 Corners of Wellness, did provide significant educational value to our community, as well. We ended 2021 with a net increase in our assets of about \$10,000. Thus, we are still in excellent shape to fund the ongoing scholarship program and future grants. We thank all those that contributed to the Foundation in 2021.

The scholarship program was the highlight of the year, even in the face of somewhat limited and delayed class offerings. Approximately \$11,200 was committed for 28 scholarship awards in 2021. Because of COVID we also extended the 1-year period allowed for use of a scholarship to 18-months for early 2020 awardees. With the new availability of on-line training, late in 2021 we also removed the location restrictions on the scholarship program. It is now available to anyone in the world who is taking US HTP or HTA classes. With this change and with class opportunities multiplying, we hope to provide even more scholarship aide to needy applicants.

Despite the economy starting to improve in 2021, there was no significant grant interest in 2021. As a result, we began to advertise for grant applications and to reach out to potential researchers. We hope those efforts will pay off in 2022.

Early in 2021 we reactivated and reconstituted our Advisory Council. That group advises the Board on policy and membership issues. Current membership is Carol Komitor, Peggy Burdick, Mary Duennes, Maddie Ferbal and Karen Chin Kelly. In addition, we developed an improved Board recruitment and vetting process and used it to bring four new members to our Board - Verna Besselink, Deborah Poelker, Stacy Borden and Leanne Bishop. They are already bringing new energy to our Board and to our operations. On the other hand, Melinda Chichester and Yolanda Alverez left our Board in 2021. We thank them both for their efforts and support. Later in 2021, the Board developed and put in place a Solicitation Registration Policy to meet State requirements for such registrations and formal Conflict-of-Interest and Privacy policies.

We look forward to a bright 2022,

GRANTS

Due to the impacts of the Covid-19 crisis, there were no new grants awarded in 2021! Below are two ongoing grants awaiting restrictions being lifted.

Ongoing Grants Impacted by COVID-19

Research Grant

The 2019 research grant for a pilot study of "The effects of Healing Touch on adult surgical patients" at the Fairview Ridges Hospital, Burnsville, MN. This pilot study to identify the positive or negative effects of Healing Touch on adult post-surgical patients with regards to pain, anxiety and/or difficulty sleeping in a community hospital setting was put on hold in April 2020 due to COVID restrictions, it is hoped that effort will be able to fully start in 2022.

Outreach Grant

In 2019 grant The Society of Healing Touch Program Alberta received an award for "Three Mini Canadian Healing Touch Program Conferences." These Mini conferences are intended to build community with practitioners and students of Healing Touch and other healing modalities, and to showcase Healing with its extensive and diverse potential for use in healing. These funds have not been expended, because of restrictions on such gatherings. Again, it is hoped that activity will occur in 2022, likely as a virtual conference.

In mid-2021 we established a committee to encourage grant activities, with a focus on research grants. The committee is working with a few individuals on potential grant applications and is developing materials on how to perform scientifically rigorous research on Healing Touch efficacy, that will be shared with the HT community throughout 2022.

It is hoped that the return to normalcy and our ongoing outreach, will lead to increased grant applications in 2022.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

2021 Scholarship Program

In 2020, HTWF implemented a scholarship program to promote Healing Touch education, offering partial scholarships for Level 1 through 6 classes for the Healing Touch Program and Healing Touch for Animals.

Scholarships are intended to support those who are interested in advancing their Healing Touch education, but may not have the financial means to do so.

FUNDRAISING

2021 was a year of major change in fundraising with much greater rewards! The fundraising committee has shifted completely to virtual events, developing two major events: Four Corners Wellness Summit and a one-day virtual workshop "Vibration Healing - How to use Sacred Geometry and Sound to Raise Healing Frequencies". These two events brought in close to 70% of our 2021 revenue!






Featured Speakers



FINANCIAL SUMMARY PAST THREE YEAR'S

As the COVID-19 pandemic continued in 2021, the foundation focused on virtual approaches to its work. The marketing committee has done excellent work on conducting their fundraising activities successfully, virtually. The previously delayed 2020 OKI conference became a Vibrational Healing virtual national event with Barbara Evans and the marketing group also held a well received 4 Corners of Wellness Summit. All proceeds from Giving Tuesday were allotted to our scholarship fund. The HTWF foundation board continued to conduct its regular meetings and annual meeting virtually also.

The scholarship program continued to grow and be utilized as we completed our first full year of having the program in place. Most of the grants expended in 2021 were toward supporting scholarships. We also provided funding to programs jointly sponsored with HTPA.
