To teach a Healing Touch Level 1 Class to Underserved Communities

Our goal is to increase accessibility of Healing Touch Level 1 classes to underserved communities who desire to learn yet are unable to pay for classes.

Healing Touch Worldwide Foundation is accepting applications to support interested Healing Touch Instructors:

-Funding is dependent on community need, available funds, and diversity of requests

Requirements:

- Have taught at least five Healing Touch Level 1 classes
- In good standing with Healing Touch Program
- Letter(s) of support from the community and/or organization leader
- An expected class of no less than 6 underserved students, roster required
- Instructor to organize all aspects of securing a facility and students to attend
- Prefer applicants that are already working with the proposed underserved community
- Instructor will adhere to the Healing Touch Program guidelines and code of ethics for coordinating and teaching the class
- Community in-kind support preferred

Examples of 'Underserved Communities' include, but are not limited to:

- > HIV positive persons
- Veterans/military families
- Survivors of slave/sex trade
- Indigenous peoples
- **LBGT communities**
- Immigrant/refugees
- Domestic abuse survivors



Compensation:

- A stipend of \$250/day (\$500 total) to the instructor
 - ~ Paid when final report & picture of the class are received
 - ~ Can be used to offset class expenses (i.e. facility, books, certificates...)

Exclusions:

HTWF does not pay any class expenses
